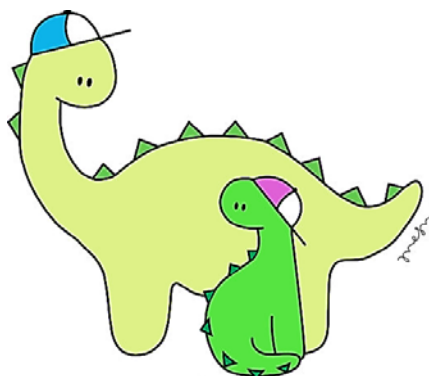
This month, we will also be taking some time to talk about how much we love our daddies and everything they do for us. We are plotting a top-secret surprise for them as well.
